Amazing Glazing

From the front, this Victorian terraced house - located within a Conservation Area - remains largely unchanged, but the rear of the property now features a striking glazed extension, providing room for a contemporary kitchen, dining and living rooms, and views out to the garden beyond.

The extension has been constructed using a glazed screen that runs between the existing party walls, with a flat roof and glazed rooflights above. At ground level, there is a level threshold between the indoor and outdoor spaces, and these areas are further linked by the uninterrupted concrete worktop that runs the length of the extension and emerges into the garden, where it is used as a barbecue and for seating. The whole of the worktop is cleverly lit from above by rooflights, egual in width to the worktop.
